The end of 2011 was by no means a time to slow down at SCT. Instead, our staff was busier than ever obtaining certifications and other training to help them better serve our customers:

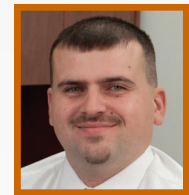
